Rules for Show and Entry

All competitors and persons attending our show are required to abide by the following rules:-

The organisers, officials, helpers and landowners cannot accept liability for accidents, injuries, damage or illness to competitors, spectators or any other person, property, horse, pony, dog or pet in connection with, or arising out of, this show. All competitors and persons attending the show do so at their own risk and are bound by these rules.

- 1 It will be a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers/promoters against any legal action arising from any accidents whatsoever
- 2 The judge's decision is final in all classes
- 3 Correct dress, footwear and hard hats must be worn and secured at all times whilst mounted. Hats should conform to the BHS/BSJA Safety standard BSEB1384 or PAS015.
- 4 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter any class on the day. If a class is cancelled refunds will be given.
- 5 Objections must be lodged with the show secretary, in writing, with a deposit of £10 within 30mins of the alleged event occurring. Deposit is refundable if the objection is upheld.
- 6 Stallions/Colts are not to be handled by any person under the age of 16yrs
- 7 No horse or pony can be entered in any ridden class under the age of 4yrs
- 8 Cruel or abusive behaviour towards horses/dogs will not be tolerated
- 9 Excessive use of whips or spurs will result in elimination
- 10 Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times
- 11 Dogs on showground on leads only - owners to clear up behind them please. Any animal showing aggressive behaviour to be removed from showground immediately.
- 12 Please ensure that the site is clean and tidy after your departure.
